 whome I putt in trust. And I give unto every one of them for their paynes a sheepe provided  
 also furthermore that I doe take Anne my bequest for to my service in my will. And I give  
 unto every one of them a sheepe. Item I give to Edward Allen tenne shilling. And to  
 the eldest sonne of Anne my daughter a sheepe. Item I give to my Anne my daughter a sheepe  
 Anne and Dorothy every one a sheepe. Item I give more to the parson in Hokenorton at my  
 deathe tenne shilling. Item I give to Edward Allen tenne shilling. Item I give to  
 Thomas Clarke twelve pence. Item I give to Anne Harris two shilling. To him that  
 went with me to the Parke two shilling. Debty that he owing unto me Richard Dalroff  
 Thomas George of Netherlathe fifty shilling. John Taylor of Woodstocke twenty shilling.  
 John Taylor of Hokenorton tenne shilling. I give Lette this my Last will and Testament

The Assentive  
 Daye of November in the year of our Lord and Redemer Jesus Christ Jurararour Anno  
 thousand five hundred ffortye and two. I William Colnett of  
 Church Ambley in the parryshe of Arcton within the Isle of Wight and County of South  
 gent being whole of bodie and in god and perfect memorye. I thank my god therfore  
 doubting the vntertainyte of this my fraille life doe therefore make and ordaine this my  
 Last will and Testament in maner and forme following. First I yelde and bequeath my  
 Soule to Almighty god my Father and maker, and maker of the heaveu the earth the sea  
 and all thing therein contayned. And to Jesus Christ Sonne of the Father both god and man  
 god of the substance of his Father before all wordes man of the substance of his mother Mary  
 the virgin begotten of her by god the father by his omnipotent power my onely Savyour Redeemer  
 Justifier and Transylter. And to the holy gost god proceeding both of the Father and the  
 Sonne my Comforter and Sanctifier by angels divine operation I make this Confession  
 Articulis quing and constantly beleeving that through the onely meritt passion deathe and  
 bloodshedding of the same Jesus Christ my deere Savyour and sould parson in Trinite I have  
 and all wayes shall have full and perfecte remission pardon and forgiveness of all my sinnes  
 unie offences and vngodlynes and shall enjoye by the same my Lorde and Savyour an ever ending  
 place of rest both for Soule and bodye with the Angells and Saints in the everlasting paradys

of god. and there shall I see in this flesh and bodily eye the whole power of the godhead. Item I will my body to be buried (if I departe this lyfe within the Isle of wight) in the churchyard of Duncton at the North Hamwell door yf not in the churchyard else where. And my funerally there to be used at the discretion of my Exorutrix and overseers Allways provided that neither sermon be made to the people for me or in my name nor almes given to the poor, nor those things excoise to belonge to the living and not to the dead. Item I give and bequeere to Almighty god (Lord I beseege) the regarde my praye and accepte my gifte) all my children be bearing the in thy holy name Johana must. And for thy sonne Jesus Christ sake that thou wouldest vouchsafe to viderse them with thy grace and holy spirit that they maye knowe and confesse the to be the only true and very god. And Jesus Christ whom thou hast sent Barnabas - Saluett my sonne thou art nowe the fruyte of youth. I will the to shewe thy selfe obedient and naturall to thy mother remember well thou must not reuoluntaire her payne. Item I will the faithfully and trustfully to imbrace thy fathers friends and diligently and thankfully to followe herre grace counsell. See thou be helpfull and loving to thy Brother and Sisters and the rest of thy poore kinfolkes. I haue made a conveyance to certain of my friends in trust for my deede and loving wyfe and thy naturall mother for her behoufe onely during her naturall lyfe of and in my maner of Lobernbe for the rent of six pound by the year other and above ffoure pound yearly to thy Brother James Saluett whiche I haue made to him by my deede during his lyfe whiche I thoughte good to acknowledge and ratifye by this my last will and testament. As touching and remannding the as thou wilt answer it before the Judgement seat of god that thou seeke not to defende or molest thy said mother and brother by any manner of wayes or means of and in the said conveyance I haue made for them during their liues. Item I give and bequeere to my sonne James Barnabas Saluett my best gatt and brothe of gods my scaling knyfe of gods three of my best swordes rapyres and daggers and gaddes my three best fyre locke peeces with therre furniture my helmet and partyson my best targett a chest with his furniture and my best Geneva Bible. Beseeching the almighty god to give the a minde all the dayes of thy lyfe to exercise thy selfe therein. Item I give and bequeere to James Saluett my sonne nowe but a three score pound of current englyshe money to be paid to my said sonne James Saluett within one quarter of a year after my deathe or otherwise before the said time as I shall hereafter appointe it by this my last will and testament. I haue given my said sonne James Saluett one Annuity of ffoure pound yearly during his naturall lyfe goinge out of my maner of Lobernbe. The deede wherof is in the the Custodye of my sony James Mellye. Item I give and bequeere to Elizabeth Saluett my daughter twoe hundred pound of current Englyshe money to be paid to my said daughter Elizabeth Saluett when she shall arramplyshe to the full age of one and twenty years or at the daye of her marriage yf it be before the terme of years before limited. Item my will and minde is that if it happen my said sonne James or my daughter Elizabeth to departe this lyfe before the receipte of therre severall Legacies (as god his will be done herein) that then his or her Legacye so decreasde be and remaine to the survivors of my said twoe children. Item my will and my minde is that if all my said children departe this naturall lyfe (as god his will be done herein) before the receipte of therre legacies that then my will and minde is therre said Legacies be and remaine to the children of my said daughter Dulcibell Sprunt, and my daughter Erare Harter in equall division. Item I will and my minde is yf my said twoe daughters Dulcibell and Erare haue none issue of therre bodies lawfully begotten that then therre before remembred Legacies be and remaine to the children of my sonne Barnabas Saluett in equall division. Item I give to my sonne in Lawe Mr John Harter and Erare Harter his wyfe my daughter charge of tenn on a daye. Whiche shall be charge of tenn a Kinge. Item I give and bequeere to every man skynne and made skynne that be dwelling with me at my departure oute of this lyfe Tenne shillinge of current money charge of tenn over and above therre wages due. The last of my good duttully and charytably whatsover my debty and Legacies fully paid and discharged. I give and bequeere to my deere and faithfull loving wyfe Annam Saluett whom I thoughte mete and ordayne sale and sole Exorutrix of this my last will and testament. And overseers of this my last will and testament

I make and ordayne my loving frende and sonne in Lawe M<sup>r</sup> John Durrant of Guilford gent  
 to whom I give forty shilling over and above all charge he shalbe at concerning this my will. and  
 John Porter gent my sonne in Lawe to whom I give for his payntes a peere of gold of Englysh  
 shilling over and above all charge he shalbe at concerning this my will. yf it please Almightye god to  
 call my wyfe Annam Durrant owte of this lyfe before this my will take place or be in force. That  
 then I will and my mynde is that Elizabeth Durrant my youngest daughter shalbe my Executrix. and  
 paye all my Debtyes before given and remembred and all my debts whatsoever. And also she shal paye  
 to her Sister Ursula Shandiffe Tenne pounde of durraut englysh money. To willm Durrant  
 my godsonne Twenty pounde. And to his Brother Abraham Durrant other Twenty pounde. And  
 here I praye and desire you my overseers even for Jesus Christ sake this my last parte of my will  
 being in force that you see my said daughter to give every one their portion appointed. And here  
 I give you full power in my stede that she without you shall not devide or give any thing. And  
 thus I beseeche the my most mercifull god and loving Father for thy sonne my Lorde Jesus Christ  
 to save my soule peere maker to graunte the success according to my meaning. Even so be it Lord

 wyfe. Item I give and bequeathe to the poore mens house of the saide parish of Surtley  
 three shillinge four pence. Item I give bequeathe and devise by this my last will and  
 Testament to my Brother Richard Water all that my messuage <sup>on the west side</sup> called the  
 together with all meadowes Leasowes pastures waych pounderward and homans to the same  
 belonging or in any wise apperteyning with all and singular therie appurtenances wherof  
 the saide Richard my Brother nowe dwelleth situate lying and being in the parish  
 of Surtley in the County of Middelsex during the terme of his naturall lyfe. And after his  
 decease I doe devise give and bequeathe all the saide messuage or Tenement with all  
 the land and rentes premises aforesaid with all and singular therie appurtenances to  
 Thomas Water eldest sonne to the saide Richard to have and to hold the saide messuage  
 or Tenement with all and singular the saide rentes premises and appurtenances to  
 the saide messuage or Tenement belonging or in any wise apperteyning to the saide  
 Thomas Water and to his heirs for ever. Item I give and bequeathe to Jane Water my  
 neece ffoure pounde of Lawfull money of England. Item I give and bequeathe to  
 Elizabeth Leyyn my sisters daughter forty shilling. Item I give and bequeathe to  
 Cible widdowes six shilling eight pence. Item I give and bequeathe to Joyce Hullen-
